

Fares Revision from Sunday 14th March 2010

We have postponed our annual review of fares (due in January 2010) as long as possible but with rising costs it is now necessary to increase some of our fares.

Greater Manchester & West Yorkshire areas

Adult fares will be revised as follows:

Lancashire Area

Most fares will be unchanged.

Some minor adjustments will be made to fares in some areas, these are mainly to remove anomalies and to ensure that similar fares are charged for travelling similar distances.

In summary, just a small number of lower distance **Adult fares** will increase by 10p and some longer distance fares over £3.00 will increase by 20p.

Customers travelling longer distances can benefit from our range of Rover Tickets which offer excellent value for money. **Rover prices will remain unchanged.**

Child Fares

The standard child fare in Greater Manchester will remain at 80p.

Child fares in other areas will be revised as follows:

New Adult Fare	New Child Fare
Upto £1.40	£1.00
£1.41 to £2.20	£1.30
£2.21 to £2.50	£1.40
£2.51 to £3.00	£1.60
£3.01 upwards	£1.80

We have tried to limit these increases in child fares, so as to impact on as few of our child passenger journeys as possible. In summary, a small number of longer distance £1.30 fares will increase to £1.40 and some longer distance £1.60 fares will increase to £1.80.
